Bathroom Protection Areas


For installations in wet-rooms, such as bathrooms, specific installation guidelines apply. These regulations differ by region. Please contact a specialist for this. Therefore electrical installations are to be performed by a skilled technician.



This product is subject to protection class IP65. This protects the product against splashing water from any angle.

Product installation

1. The distance between the two holes for installation is A, and the height from the ground B must be the same. Measure the installation location and mark it. (For the specific size of A and B, please refer to the size table according to the product model, and the installation height according to the size table, the bottom of the mirror from the ground is 1100mm)





2. Punch two 8*60mm holes in the marked position, knock the expansion tube into the holes untill it is even as the wall surface, and then fix the two hangers onto walls by screws.

3. Fasten the buckle behind the smart mirror with the screws fixed on the wall.

Note: The load-bearing capacity of the installation wall should be no less than four times of that by the product.






Bathroom Protection Areas

Just power on(if there is socket behind the mirror, please connect power first and then hang the mirror on the bracket)

To guarantee electric safety and stability of functions during use, please ensure that the product iseffectively grounded.



Important notes:

If the 86 line box is installed on the wall behind the smart mirror, it is a must for professionals to cut off the AC cord plug and connect the power supply by wiring.

Note the following:

- 1. Wiring operators must be certified electricians.
- 2.The main gate must be shut down during wiring operation. Power-on is strictly prohibited.
- 3. Undocumented personnels are strictly prohibited to operation by themselves.

AC wire trimming wiring instructions

1. Cut off the power cord plug according to the actual length required.



2. Strip off the black insulating layer on the outside to avoid damaging the insulating layer of the inner cable when stripping. Strip the insulation layer of the inner cable to avoid damaging the core when stripping.




Note: A crimping cap with regular insulation and flame retardant must be used for insulation.

 Begin to measure after binding successfully.



















Skin detector measuring:

- 4. Push the bottom button again to open skin detector, and choose body part to measure.















- 1. The measuring is continuing when indicator light is blue, and keep a close contact with the skin until measuring done.
- 2. View the analysis report after measuring done.






ELECTRICITY AND SAFETY

- 1. Never remove the housing covers or modify the product in any way. This can cause an electric
- 2. Do not overload wall outlets, extension cords or adaptors above their capacity, since this can result in fire or electric shock.
- 3. Immediately cut power, if you notice that your product emits smoke, smells burnt or emits unusual noises and ask your specialist dealer for advice.

- 9. The device is rated to be connected to a mains with rating max. 16A. The electrical installation need to be protected with 30 mA.
- 10. Never cut or damage the power cord!
- 11. Please disconnect the device from the power supply in the following cases:
- The device is out of use for a lengthy period.
- The device malfunctions or displays other unusual features, necessitating maintenance work.
- During a thunderstorm or lightning.
- 12. Do not use multiple products with a single power socket.

Installation

- 1. Avoid direct sun exposure, direct proximity to heat sources, outdoor installation or storing in a car. The product is specifically designed for indoor use only. There is the danger of fire and of electric shocks and damage to the device, if it is operated outdoors.
- 2. Do not place candles, insect repellants or cigarettes on top of the product. Do not install the product near to heat sources.
- 3. Keep the plastic packaging out of reach of children, children may suffocate.

- 12. The corners and edges of the glass are very delicate. Take care that they do not hit the wall, ceiling or floor in any way to avoid damages and split-offs.
- 13. The surface of the glass is very sensitive. Do not use a cutter or knife to remove the protective foil in order to avoid scratches and other damages.
- 14. The product is delivered with a protective film covering the glass in order to avoid scratches and damages. Only remove the protective film once the product is installed and hanging safely on the wall.
- 15. Installing the product in an unusual place (a place exposed to a lof of fine dust, chemical substances, extreme temperatures or a significant presence of moisture, or a place where the product will operate continuously for an extended period of time) may seriously affect its performance and lifetime.

- 17. There are numerous types of wall and structures, that 's why we can not provide the fittings, screws and anchors for your wall. First determine the type of wall to which you want to attach the product in order to buy the appropriate fittings, screws and anchors.
- 18. Mounting this product requires structural measures and special skills. Refer exclusively to qualified personnel. Electrical connections must be performed by qualified professionals expecting national regulations and standards.
- 19. For installations in wet-rooms, such as bathrooms, specific installation guidelines apply. These regulations differ by region. Please contact a specialist for this. Therefore electrical installations are to be performed by a skilled technician, while observing the regulations of the standard DIN VDE 0100 T.701.
- 20. This product includes heavy, bulky and delicate items. To prevent damages to your product or injury to yourself or to others, prepare the installation environment properly. Clean the handling and installation environments properly before installation. Before installation cushion the floor properly using soft anti slip mats near the handling areas. Lay the items gently on these cushioned anti slip surfaces when needed.





Operation

- 1. There is a high voltage inside the product. Never disassemble, repair or modify the product yourself.
- 2. Before moving the product, disconnect the power cable.
- 3. If the product is dropped or the outer case is damaged, disconnect the power cord. Then contact the service center.
- 4. Do not drop objects on the product or apply impact.
- 5. If a gas leakage is found, do not touch the product or power connection. Also, ventilate the area immediately.
- 6. Do not use or keep combustible spray or an inflammable substance near the product.
- 7. Do not insert metallic objects (chopsticks, coins, hairpins, etc) or objects that burn easily (paper, matches, etc) into the product.
- 8. Do not place objects containing liquid (vases, pots, bottles, etc) or metallic objects on top of the product.
- 9. Leaving the screen fixed on a stationary image for an extended period of time may cause afterimage burn-in or defective pixels.
- 10. Do not hold the product upside-down.
- 11. Do not use humidifiers or stoves around the product.
- 12. Store small accessories out of the reach of children.

- 13. Do not place heavy objects (e.g. decor frames) on the product.
- 14. Be careful that children do not place the battery in their mouths when removed from the remote control. Place the battery in a location that children or infants cannot reach.

Operation

The product must be stored in dry and well-ventilated rooms, without extreme temperature fluctuations. Heat sources and aggressive active substances may not be stored in the proximity of the device. The required storage temperature is 0° C $- +60^{\circ}$ C at an air humidity of 5 - 85% RH. The device must be stored in the complete packaging, as delivered.



Home network and Wi-Fi requirements for bathroom application

Overview:

Bathrooms are usually enclosed by walls which cause attenuation. Rooms, on the other hand, have windows which allow cellular/Wi-Fi signal to enter and propagate more easily.

Bathrooms might have metal sheet on the door to prevent its wood from getting soaked. This reflects away most of the RF signal.

There is a network of pipes which impedes signal and creates multi-path

Water (and moisture) absorbs radio signal at higher frequencies. This is why microwave ovens operate at ~2.4GHz, which incidentally is the same as WiFi

Minimum Requirements:

You will need a high-speed DSL/Cable modem, or fiber-to-the-home broadband connection for proper playback of Internet-based music and video

If your Internet service provider only offers Satellite Internet access, you may experience playback issues due to fluctuating download rates.

In order to take advantage of Smart Mirror's automatic online updates, or stream music and video from an Internet-based content provider, you must install a wireless router in your home network.

If you do not have a wireless router, purchase and install one before proceeding

Please make sure your router, modem and/or wireless network specifications meet the followings:

Wireless Network Specifications: Open, WEP, WPA-PSK or WPA2-PSK encryption. Wireless Router/Modem Specifications: B.G or N routers on 2.4GHz

Connect a Wi-Fi Range Extender to your Wi-Fi system if:

- You have a larger home where the WiFi performance isn't reliable and you want to strengthen the wireless reception in your bathroom for your Smart Mirror.
- Your WiFi network is already in high demand with streaming video and web surfing and you want to create a separate wireless network exclusively for your Smart Mirror.

Helpful hints once experiencing "buffering" on streaming content.

- Try to move your Wireless Access Point away from physical objects that can block your Wi-Fi signal especially enclosed cabinets.
- Restart your network device (router, wap, extender etc.)
- Analyze which channel your Wi-Fi is using. You can do this with help Wi-Fi Analyzer app available in play store. Change your router setting in such a way that your channel is different from your neighbors Wi-Fi. The app itself shows recommendations for the channel.

Cleaning and Product Care

- 1. Use a soft damp cloth (cotton, flannel, etc.) and gently wipe the surface of the product. Wiping with a hard cloth or using strong force may scratch the surface of the product. Never touch, push, rub or strike the screen with any object.
- 2. Avoid using benzene, thinner and other solvents as they may deform the product and may cause the paint to peel off or damage the surface. Using a chemical cloth (wet/dry sheet type cloth, etc.) may cause damages and corrode the product. To avoid deformation, corrosion and color fading, wipe off water drops as soon as possible.
- 3. The following items may never be used for cleaning: solvents, cleaning petrol, scrubbing milk, spray cleaner, wax, acids, caustic solutions or the like. These agents may cause damages and corrode the product.

User Warranty

1. Warranty time.

Smart mirror -12 months. It guarantees that the Seller smart mirror (including the touch mirror, the screen, frame, and all built-in hardware elements (e.g., camera, processor). Body fat scales -12 months. Only if the customer requires the body fat scales with the mirror.

Installation - 1 month. For Seller smart mirror initially installed by authorized Seller technicians by Video guiding, If there is special project, Seller will offer door to door

2. Warranty process

- 1) When customer report a warranty case, it needs include the problem detail, when Seller get the case. Seller after service team needs the technical report. The report will be confirmed with both Seller technical team and customer's technical team. If it needs the special technical support from the third party, we will determine who will be responsible for the third party fee depends on the case.
- 2) When Seller confirm the warranty, Seller will follow the warranty steps, pls go to: How Seller do the warranty.
- 3) All of the order will be inspected before delivery in the Seller Factory, The customer needs to inspect again right after the goods arrive the port or arrive the customers' warehouse. Both part can negotiate those detail after the first 100 pcs orders.

How Seller do the warranty?

- 1) If the problem can fix by replacement parts, Seller will send the replacement part together with new order to customer, if it is urgent and under agreement, Seller will send the replacement part separately, Seller will be responsible for the shipping fee.
- 2) If the problem cant fix by replacement parts, Seller will send new product with next order, if it is under agreement, Seller will refund the money to customer directly or use this money as next orders' deposit
- 3) If both side is under agreement, Seller can send the replacement part together with the order shipment base on some defective rate, this rate can be negotiated after formal orders or under the situation that both side can agree.
- 4) If there is urgent requirement from the customer, Seller can do the door to door support with agreement.

For more warranty method, it can be negotiated depends on the cooperation.
